Bands will be ushered from the Warm Up Room to side stage, then ushered to the Case Storage after the performance.


Bands are requested to wait and follow directions to avoid unnecessary confusion and noise spill.

THE EMPIRE THEATRE PRECINCT

The Empire Theatre precinct is ideally set up for contesting. Trade Stands, warm up area and performance venue are conveniently close to each other. There is an on-site restaurant, ample parking in two large council car parks on Neil Street. Restaurants, bars and cafes within walking distance of the Empire and many commodious parks and gardens to spend a few hours.



PARADE OF BANDS

Inspection will be 15 minutes prior to the start of the grade.

PARADE OF BANDS

The location for the Parade of Bands will be the TAFE oval directly behind the Cobb & Co Museum on Lindsay Street. It is GRASSED, will be mowed short and the ground is level. The inspection area is bitumen, with the march having two direction changes to the right, finishing adjacent to the stepping off place.


As the area is relatively small, bands will complete their march before the next band steps off. Bands are encouraged to perform their turns with flare as this is a judged maneuver.

Non-competitive bands and concert bands are not required to participate in the Parade of Bands.

The parade is a compulsory event if they wish to be considered for the Champion Band in their grade. While Parade of Bands points are not included in the Championship, bands cannot win the championship without completing the Parade of Bands.

Please organize a representative from your band to march with your band banner.
